November 18, 2003 – Quantum Devices, Inc. (QDI) is proud to announce it has recently received FDA clearance to market its WARP 10 product as Safe and Effective for intended use. The WARP 10 is a high intensity, portable, Near-IR lighting unit intended for the temporary relief of minor muscle and joint pain, stiffness, arthritis and muscle spasm; promoting relaxation of muscle tissue; and to temporarily increase local blood circulation where applied.

QDI developed the Warfighter Accelerated Recovery by Photobiomodulation, WARP 10, under contract to DARPA (Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency). The WARP 10 was developed to assist the Warfighter (armed forces personnel) on the front lines with immediate first aid and care for minor injuries and pain, thereby improving the Warfighter's endurance in combat situations.

QDI's core technology is high intensity, wavelength specific, solid state lighting systems. QDI has been awarded several domestic and foreign patents, with others pending, for the use of their core technology in medical and agriculture research. QDI's SpectraLife[®] and Quanta-Med[®] lighting systems are considered the gold standards for photobiomodulation research and photo dynamic cancer therapy.

QDI originally developed its high intensity solid state lighting technology fourteen years ago for NASA. NASA was looking for a high intensity, low heat generating, lighting system to support the agriculture needs of long range manned space missions. Success with NASA lead to commercialization of the technology into other areas of basic research resulting in the WARP 10
